








DIVE INTO THE HEART OF THE MONTGOLFIADES by Kavier and Caroline HIKES & TRAVEL \$ 2.5 UT.





e were lucky enough to be invited right into the heart of this event to experience it and share it with you. as if you were there... There were different activities scheduled during the Montgolfiades weekend, particularly for families, including Mini Hot Air Balloons and "Teddy Bear Flights". Where children could bring their soft toy along with them to give them a mini flight and receive a souvenir photo. There were also workshops, such as building wooden figures or kites, and rifle shooting. It was with the Team Ballon Yutz, led by Gégé and Coco (Gérard and Christian), that we had the chance to fully experience this activity from start to finish, with the invaluable support of Pauline, Gérard's daughter, who competes in the French championships! We were able to help them set up the basket and inflate the sail (balloon) part. To begin with, the basket lies on the ground and is connected to the balloon. A large fan blows air inside while the team secures the top section. Once the balloon is properly inflated with cold air. Pauline activates the burner to heat the air, and the hot air halloon can then take off. Before the burner was lit. we even had the chance to step inside the balloon: an absolutely incredible and amazing experience!

Finally, the basket rights itself, the balloon rises, and we were able to climb inside before gaining altitude. The takeoff is smooth: you barely feel yourself leaving the ground, with no sensation of vertigo at all...



The hot air balloon travels with the wind. and we were pushed to the wrong side of the valley, which shortened our flight, but it was memorable nonetheless! We were able to admire the entire Aravis mountain range. especially the Mont Charvin and the Mont-Blanc massif, surrounded by other hot air balloons. We finally landed safely in a small alpine pasture accessible via a forest road. In general, the pilots try to land near roads to make it easier to recover the very heavy equipment: the balloon alone weighs about 135 kg, and the basket has to be loaded onto the trailer. Before leaving our crew, we had a toast to the association with crémant (a sparkling wine) and were presented with our hot air ballooning ascent certificate! An unforgettable experience, shared with a fantastic team!

Hello Antonin, you are part of the Spanish Ice Cross Federation. We discovered you in our magazine in 2024, in an article dedicated to the discovery of this impressive, lesser known sport. Today you are part of a new adventure, the making of a film to show us behind the scenes and to prove that it's good to believe in your dreams.

In this film, I wanted to highlight the entire sporting aspect, the relationship with my partners, my family and friends, everyone who supports me, and to show that we are also reaching a new scale. The sport was created by Red Bull in 2001, and it received huge media coverage for 17 years. In 2018, Red Bull withdrew. Thanks to this documentary, we aim to show the beauty of the sport above all, through simple values such as commitment, family, and following your dream.

In the film we see the risks that you take, you are playing with fire skating on blades that are 4mm wide and 20cm long.

Yes it's a risky sport, which takes a lot of energy from me, as well as from my physio, my family and friends, and my physical trainer Bastien Durand, who has been there since the beginning and who also trains the tennis player Lois Bosson. I am fully aware that the reason I am here today is thanks to everybody's support.

What are your goals for the upcoming months?


I do my physical training on the pumptracks of the region, where I really like to train. Then, as for specific training, at the beginning of January I will go (in between two races) to the ice pistes in Austria.

MOUNTAIN BIKE STADIUM

THE PROJECT

The objective is to create progressive mountain bike (MTB) routes accessible to everyone, enabling practice for both beginners and experienced riders. These itineraries will incorporate more technical and demanding natural and artificial sections, whilst also offering gentler variations for beginners.

Two distinct zones will be developed which will enable the following:

To offer trainers the possibility to vary their routes and achieve different teaching objectives

To expand the leisure activities on offer for families with fun and suitable circuits

To complete the existing offer already present in the area, alongside the Val d'Arly FFC MTB site, the Saisies Espace Diamant, and the Portes du Mont-Blanc MTB Area

The project is a priority for the Cycling Club, which is developing its MTB section; it will also serve the school and the general public.

Ophélie_ For me it's Praz lake, the calm of the water is so relaxing and exotic, it's a little corner of paradises.


Gaëlle_ Tell us about your job.

Gaëlle_Describe your favourite place...

Roger_ For me, everywhere in Praz is unique and magnificent. With the 4 seasons, it changes all the time, I am always filled with wonder.

Mickaël_ For me, it's the private pasture des Châteaux, a beautiful hike, sleeping under the stars, and I can't hide my joy when I see a shooting star. Gaëlle_ There aren't many Blacksmiths around

Roger_ I learned the trade on the 27th October 1955, that date is etched on my mind forever. For 3 years, I was fitting horseshoes to the horses' feet. You had to stay calm, be precise, and be careful not to get kicked. And then one day, it just clicked; I struck out on my own, and after 65 years, I still have just as much love for this profession.

Mickaël_ I came across it at a very young age. I learned with my father when I was 10. I used when it was cold. Now with the new lift, it is to weld snow stoppers; I was fascinated by the material, the shaping of the iron that bends under the effect of heat, and which then regains its hardness for a lifetime.

Gaëlle_ What will you never forget in Praz? **Roger_** *I participated in the elaboration of 80* seats for the Rosière Chairlift by welding the safety guards. I am moved, as there is a part of me in the creation of the ski lifts.

Mickaël_ When working on the ski area, I enjoyed witnessing the transformation of the ski lifts, the evolution of the artificial snow, and the lake that supplies our snow cannons

Gaëlle_ Where's your favourite place? **Fabrice** Le Novex on the way to Les Bernards, my place of life, my paradise.

Gaëlle_ Why did you choose Praz-sur-Arly?

Fabrice_ *Firstly for love : my wife comes from* here, I also loved the village straight away. In Praz, the stillness, the quality of life and the mentality of the inhabitants who know how to take time, relaxes and soothes me.

Gaëlle_ A significant memory?

Fabrice_ My first summer camp was in 1985 at the Chalet du Remonte-Pente, connected to the town of La Ciotat. I still cherish wonderful memories—crazy golf at Chantalouette, camping, and unforgettable adventures. Years later, I met a 'Praline' with whom I started a family. 

THE TONNAZ HAMLET



Today it is the starting point of numerous hikes and a must see of the Praz-sur-Arly heritage which will delight all amateurs of traditional architecture of the region.



ince 1986, this local folk group made up of about twenty enthusiasts heartily perpetuates the traditions of Praz-sur-Arly, through songs, dances and costumes from the past. Their name 'Gapian' is a reference to the ancient customs officers of the large Franche zone [1860-1923] when the border passed between Praz and Flumet. But it also conjures up an image of someone who is mischievous, a rascal, full of life! With a festive and convivial atmosphere, the Gapians reproduce scenes from the past, telling the story of the village and its inhabitants. Their shows are a real immersion into the vibrant cultural heritage of the Val d'Arly.







Winter Activities



Snowshoeing in autonomy

ot a big fan of sliding downhill but in love with the alpine atmosphere? No problem! In Praz-sur-Arly, you have the possibility to go for a snowshoe hike on our two marked routes from the bottom of the ski slopes (near the car park):

• The Cassioz loop: discover a unique viewpoint of the Val d'Arly, taste the charm of life in the hamlets, with this itinerary open to everyone. With beautiful views of Mount Charvin, Megève and Praz, as well as the hamlets of Cassioz and Thouvassières. This loop is a nice introduction for anyone wishing to discover this practice! Count about 1 hour 40 minutes for a round trip, with a distance of 3km and a slight elevation gain of 150m.

• The Evettes loop: throughout this route, the forest opens into beautiful glades where walkers can enjoy magnificent views of the Aravis and the Arly valley. Have a little stop at the lake of Evettes where you will find two mountain restaurants to have a greatly appreciated break, here a magical atmosphere is guaranteed, especially after a fresh snowfall!

Count about 2 hours 30 minutes for a round trip, with a distance of 4.8km and an elevation gain of 220m.

A topoguide of 64 marked snowshoeing routes (310km) in the Pays du Mont-Blanc is also available for sale at the Tourist Office. (2€) Discover the surrounding area with snowshoes.

Learn to ski

n the past I was a professional in ski-mountaineering, and at the end of my sporting career I was looking for a new challenge in my life, so that is why I applied to become the director of the ESF ski school. I manage a very dynamic team of 40 ski instructors of all ages. Each of these instructors possess a professional bi-qualification and organise their time as they can, or wish. I have instructors who work the whole season and work every day, others who work only at weekends and during the school holidays. 
